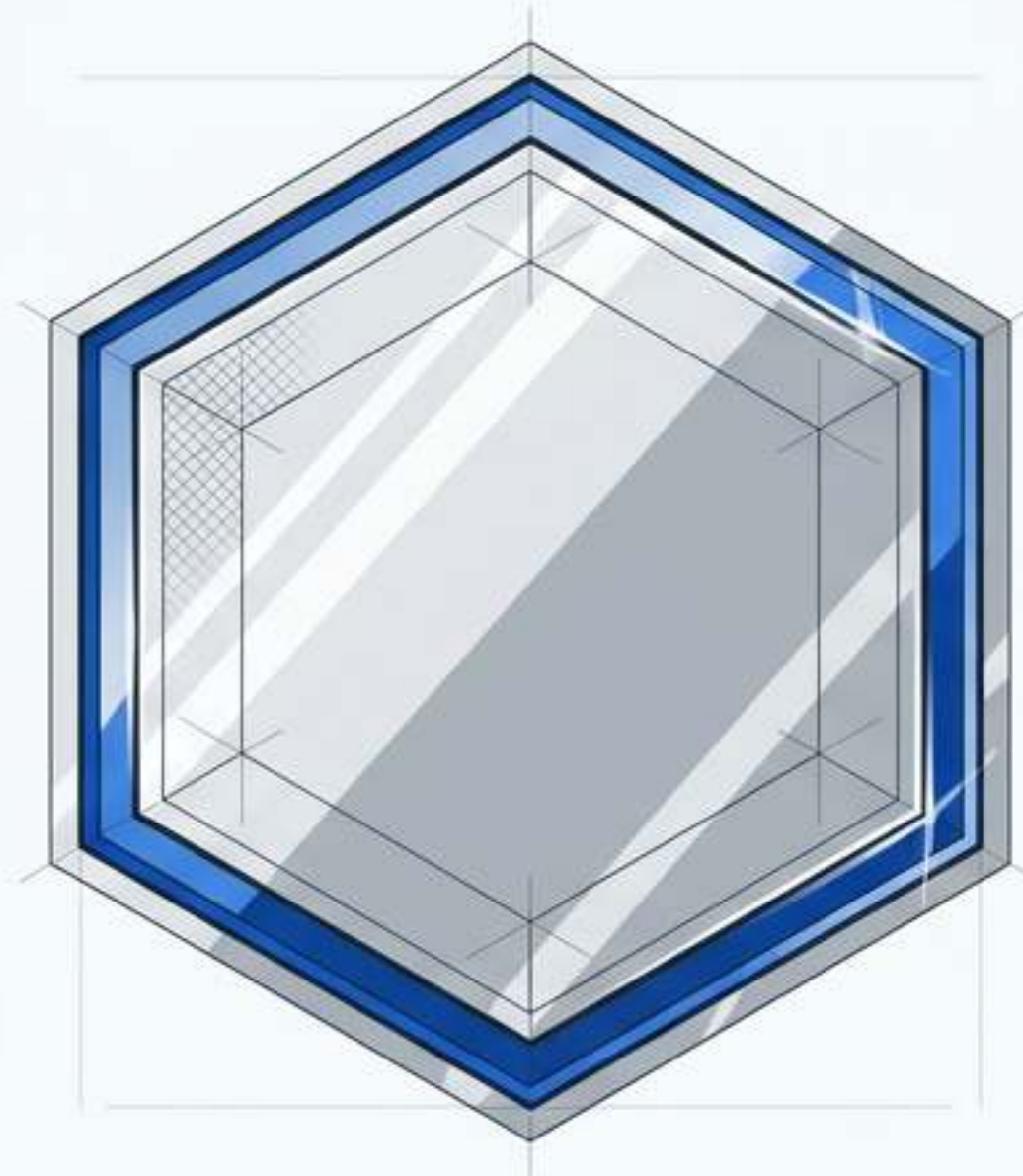

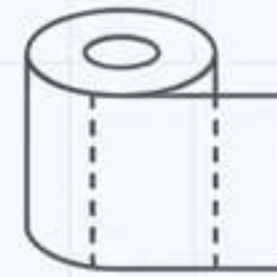
Custom Mirror Stickers

- ☒ Best when the project specifically dictates a reflective/mirror base rather than a broader category.



Custom Die Cut Stickers

- ☐ Pivot here when you need standard materials, unique die-cut shapes, or distinct production routes suited to general die-cut use cases.



Custom Roll Labels

- ☐ Pivot here when the packing route requires rolls (e.g., for machine application) rather than individual cuts.



Custom Transfer Stickers

- ☐ Pivot here when the use case demands transfer/decal application without background material.



The 7 Pillars of a Custom Quote

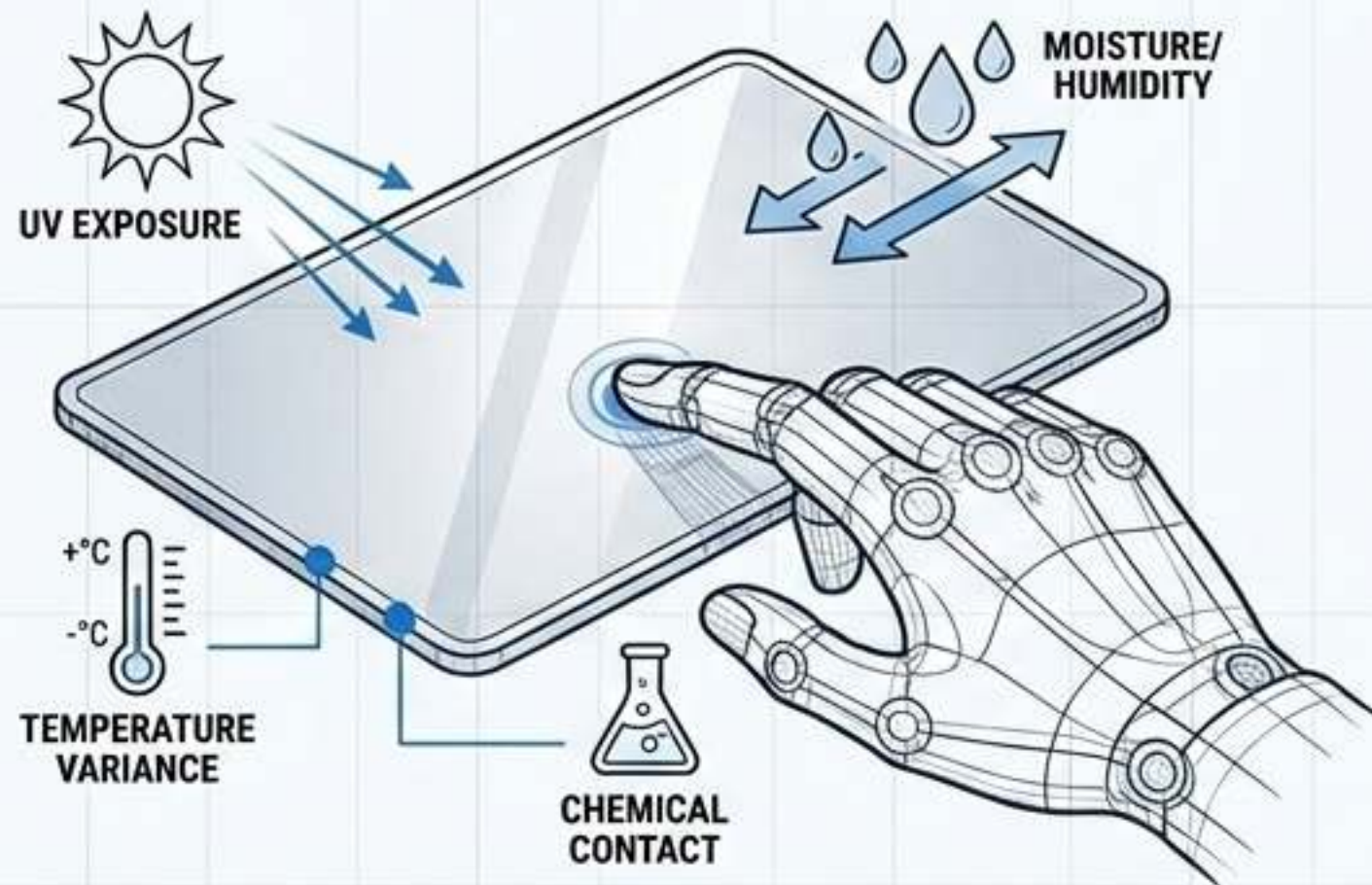
Every variable impacts the final production specs. Define these pillars before requesting your quote.



Pillar 1 & 2: Environment and Dimensions

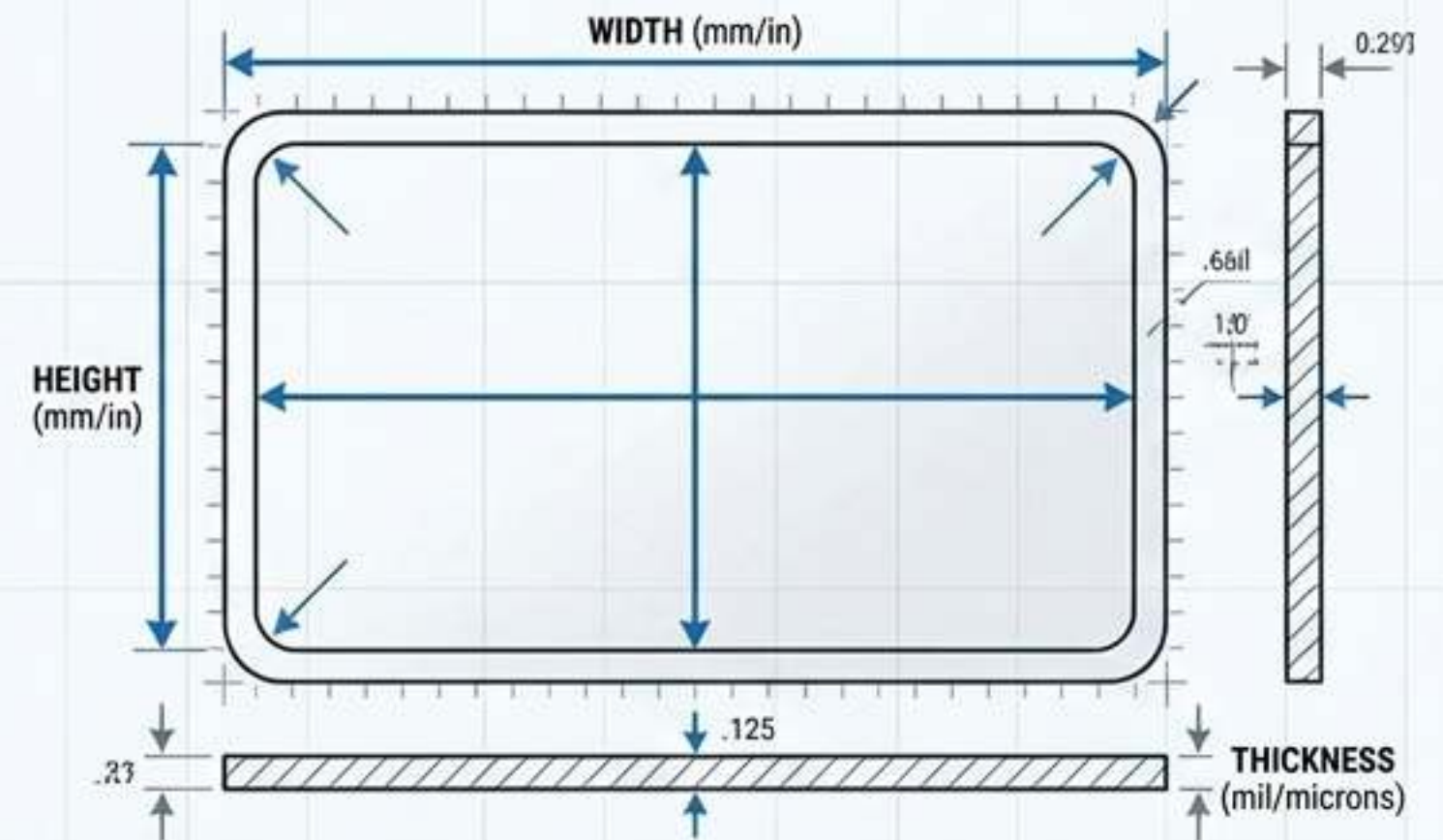
Comparing practical choices before locking in specifications.

Pillar 1: Environment



Start with the real use case. Where will the item be seen or handled? Environmental exposure dictates material durability.

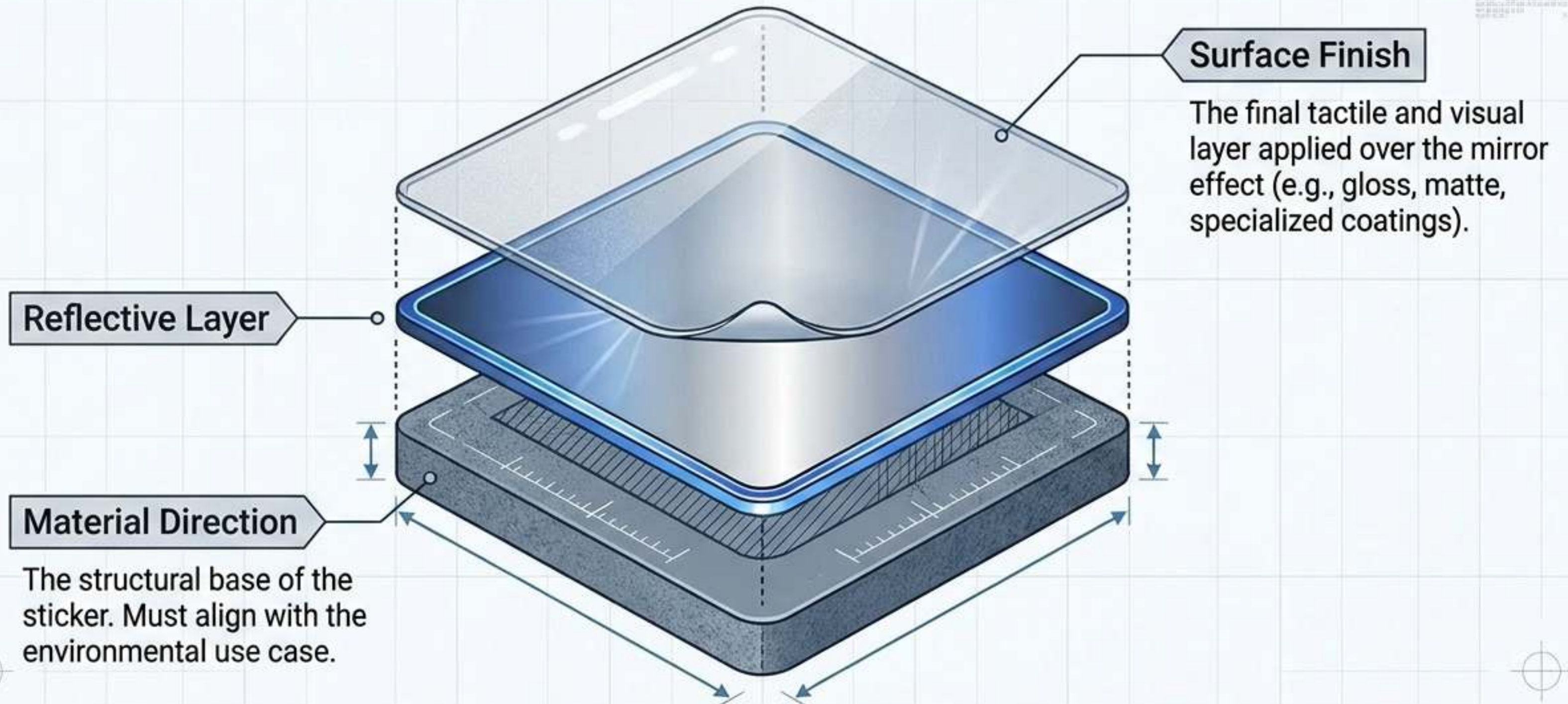
Pillar 2: Dimensions



Confirm specific size targets. Dimensions dictate layout, tooling, and cost efficiency.

Pillar 3 & 4: Material Direction & Surface Finish

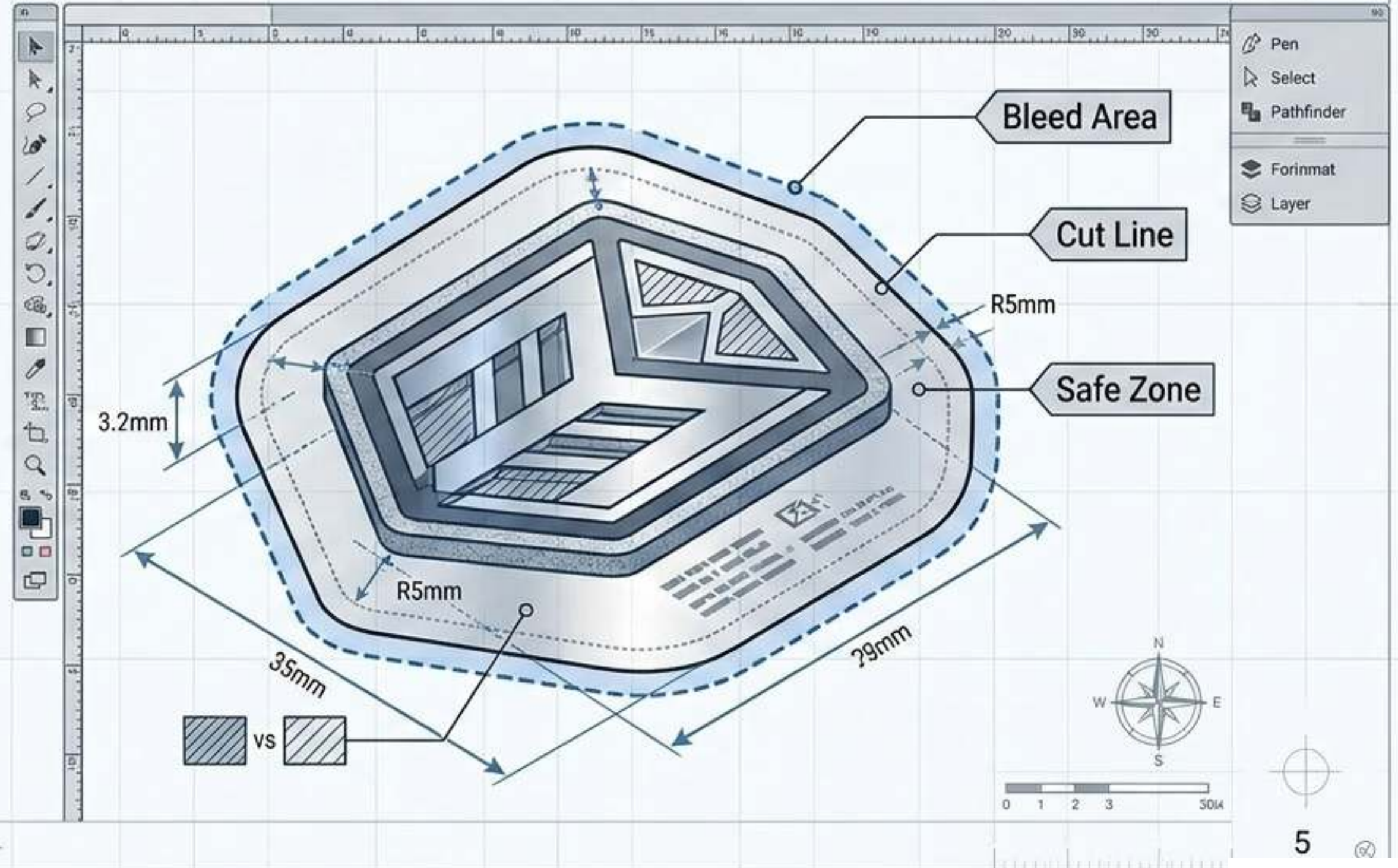
Confirm both preferences clearly in your initial specification review.



Pillar 5: Artwork & File Preparation

A final quote requires an artwork file or a highly accurate reference.

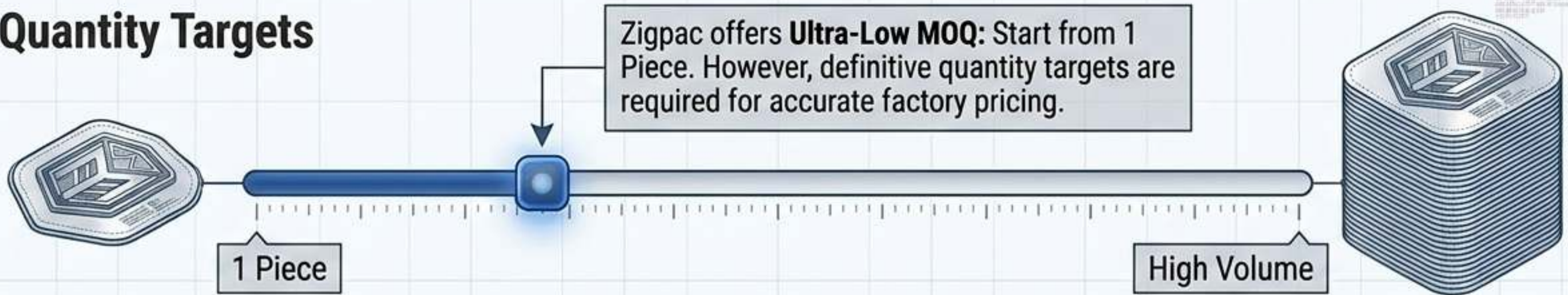
- ✓ Vector format preferred.
- ✓ Clearly define the cutline/shape.
- ✓ Indicate which specific areas of the design utilize the mirror effect versus opaque ink.



Pillar 6 & 7: Quantity & Logistics

Define your quantity targets and packing needs for precise factory quotation.

Quantity Targets

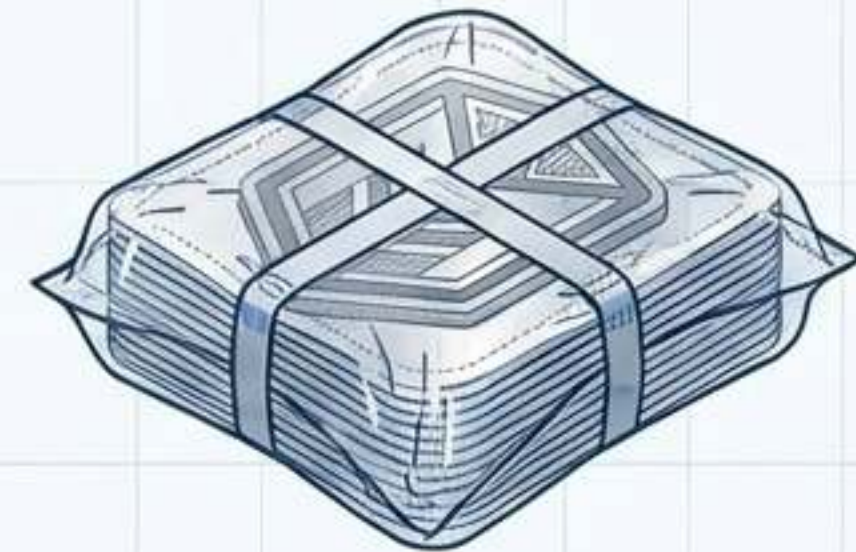


Packing Needs

Define your delivery format.
Will these be distributed individually or applied in batches?
Packing routes impact final specifications.

Production Realities: What Not to Assume

Standardized constraints do not apply to custom manufacturing.
Do not assume these details before the final specification review.



MOQ

Not fixed. Dependent on final specs.

Lead Time

Not fixed. Dependent on final specs.

Certifications

Specific material/safety certs depend on the chosen specifications.

Shipping Terms

Finalized only after size, quantity, and packing are locked.

Final quote and timeline can only be issued after a complete, reviewed, and approved **technical specification** document.

The Pre-Quote Checklist

- ☐ 1. Use Case defined (environment/handling)
- ☐ 2. Size Target defined (dimensions/shape)
- ☐ 3. Material Direction selected
- ☐ 4. Surface Finish preference confirmed
- ☐ 5. Artwork File (or accurate reference) ready
- ☐ 6. Quantity Target identified
- ☐ 7. Packing Needs specified
